Guidance:

- 1. Each child will have their own complete packet of observation forms for each domain.
- 2. Complete the Child and Class information for each child.
- 3. Add the child's name to each page.
- 4. Record one observation for each objective/learning progression
- 5. ELA observations are shaded gray for reference.
- 6. Record the initials of the person who took the observation and the date the observation was observed.
- 7. Record the ELA Score for ECE children ONLY.
- 8. County Managers will check for progress by recording the number of observations both written and entered into TSG at each County Team Staffing.
- 9. The ELA Summary sheet is just for the classes that have ECE children enrolled.
- 10. Record the children's names across the top of the document.
- 11. Record their individual scores for all domains, strands, and learning progressions.
- 12. This process will be completed for each checkpoint time frame.
- 13. Once the observations are entered into TSG, you will send the observation sheets and the completed score sheet into the C.O. to <u>Carmen</u>, (Or give them to her at the Computer Lab). She will copy the observation sheets and return them for you to use for planning and then place in the child's file.
- 14. This process repeats for the remaining observation checkpoint timeframes.
